Measure SMS is a \$485 million general obligation bond placed on the November 6, 2018 ballot by the SMMUSD to upgrade school safety and campus security, make critical major changes to 70-100-year-old schools, and modernize pre-Kindergarten to 12th grade classrooms for 21st-century academics. There is not, nor will there be, State money to address these needs, making

Measure SMS our only option. Every dollar raised by Measure SMS will be used exclusively for Santa Monica schools through the newly-created SMMUSD School Facilities Improvement District No. 1. Not one cent can be taken away by the State or go to Malibu schools. Malibu voters will vote on a separate bond for their schools.



What will Measure SMS do?

- Our schools will be retrofitted for today's higher earthquake and fire safety standards.
- Campus security systems will be upgraded with the latest technology.
- Outdated electrical, plumbing and energy systems will be replaced and hazardous materials removed, creating a safer, healthier learning environment.
- Leaky roofs, worn-out floors, rusty plumbing, and unhygienic bathrooms and locker rooms will be repaired.
- Our children will have access to the 21st-century learning tools they need for college and today's careers.
