## **Electronics Recycling Day is Friday, January 12th!**

Bring your old electronics down to Franklin on Friday, January 12th, for a free recycling pick-up service brought to you by our school's Green Team and [California Recycles](#).

From 8:15 am to 3:30 pm, drive/walk/bike down the WESTERN alley from Montana towards Idaho. Half way down you'll find the drop-off spot on your left, just after the MPR. A volunteer will be available to help you unload. If you are recycling a computer you'll need to sign a form with your contact info; otherwise it's just "drop & go." It's THAT easy to keep heavy metals out of our landfills and repurpose what we can!
